

COMPETITION RULES "BELGIAN TREASURES" – INSTAGRAM CONTEST

ARTICLE 1

Brussels Airport Company NV (BAC), with its registered offices at 1030 Brussels, Auguste Reyerslaan 80, with enterprise number 0890.082.292 is/are organising a competition without purchase obligation, from 12 am on 11/09/2019 until and including 11.59 pm on 03/11/2019.

ARTICLE 2

Participation in this competition is open to all individuals aged 18 or over, with the exception of: staff members of BAC and its partners, advertising agencies engaged by BAC and any other persons who worked on setting up the current competition.

The following persons are also excluded from participating in this competition: family members in the first degree of the persons listed in the previous paragraph, as well as persons residing at the same permanent address as the persons listed in the previous paragraph.

By entering the competition, participants will be deemed to have accepted these competition rules without any reservation. No disputes will be accepted regarding the wording of the questions and concerning the answers to the questions

Minors may only participate in online competitions with the express permission of one (1) of their parents or their guardian. Brussels Airport Company will assume that any minor entering a competition is doing so with the permission of their parents or guardian. Minors who are unable to provide confirmation of this permission may at any time be denied further participation in the competition or have their right to a prize taken away.

ARTICLE 3

In order to validly participate in the contest, please connect to your personal public Instagram account and post a permanent photo with a Belgian Treasure at Brussels Airport and the hashtag #brusselsairport. For these purposes, "Belgian Treasures" shall include everything that Belgians would be proud of: Belgian specialties, inventions, fashion, culture, sport, etc.

Only photos that meet these requirements shall be valid. A jury appointed by the Organiser of the Contest will assess the originality, creativity and beauty of the photo before declaring the winner.

Incomplete entries will be excluded from the contest. Contestants may post multiple entries via their personal Instagram account if they wish but can only win a maximum of one prize.

BAC will select 1 winner per week, who will be awarded 1 prize
