



# Mobility Flash - March 2026

Dear colleague,

With this Mobility Flash, we would like to inform you about upcoming works on the access roads to and from Brussels Airport. Below please find an overview of the major changes for **March & April**.

## 1. Work on the Ring Road – Traffic light installation during the weekend of March 13–15

During this weekend, traffic flows on the flyover bridges above the Brussels Ring Road (R0) will be modified. The work will be carried out in phases, with diversions clearly marked with mobile signage.

### Impact:

- No access from the inner ring road to the airport.
- The Evere–airport connection via the A201 will be closed.

Allow for **extra travel time** and consider using **public transport**. After the weekend, two junctions will operate with temporary traffic lights. [More info & maps](#).

## 2. Work on the Strabet roundabout from April 13 through June 15, 2026

The Strabet roundabout will be completely redesigned and closed to traffic for nine weeks.

**From April 13 to April 19**, the roundabout will be **completely closed** to all traffic. From April 20 to June 15, only buses and emergency services will be allowed to pass through.

Throughout the entire period, **diversions** will be in place to ensure access to the airport and your workplace. For your convenience, we will provide a **turning loop with traffic lights** after the A201 flyover to keep traffic flowing smoothly. [Discover the routes relevant to you](#).

**Cyclists and pedestrians** coming from Zaventem will only be affected from April 13 to April 19:

- From Zaventem to Ringlaan, you will be diverted via Olmenstraat.
- You can also take Groenstraat to the cycle highway to connect to TechZuid.
- You cannot leave the airport by bike or on foot via the Strabet roundabout. From the terminal, go to Tech Zuid towards the cycle highway and take the “Groenstraat” exit to go to Zaventem.
