



Mobility Flash - May 2026

Dear colleague,

With this Mobility Flash, we would like to inform you about upcoming works on the access roads to and from Brussels Airport. Below please find an overview of the major changes for **May & June***.

1. Work on the Strabet roundabout until June 14

The Strabet roundabout is currently being redesigned and will remain **fully closed until and including June 14**. The diversions in place since mid-April will continue to apply. Please follow the on-site diversion signage at all times. Whenever possible, we recommend using public transport or cycling to reach the airport.

Need to get to the terminal? With your **airport badge**, you can also take the **South Ringlaan**: enter at skeyes and exit at car park 41 - TUI. It's quick and convenient!

2. New temporary bus station from 7 May

Starting **7 May**, the bus station will move to a temporary location on **level 0**, accessible via a **covered walkway from the terminal**. **All bus and coach services** will operate from there: De Lijn (8 lines), MIVB Line 12, Flibco, Flixbus, Airport Express, Touring Cars, as well as hotel, car park and skeyes shuttles. Bus and coach services will later move to the **new intermodal hub**, planned for **2029–2030**.

Attention! Due to asphaltting and road marking work at the **P31/P16/Drop-off intersection**, diversions will apply for buses and staff on P30 on the **nights of May 4 and 5**. Find out more on the [mobility page](#).

3. Work on the Ring Road: nighttime closures and restricted lanes

Due to works on the Ring Road, your route to the airport may be temporarily affected:

- **May 4–16 (10:00 p.m.–3:00 a.m.):** Nighttime closures of the exit from the inner Ring Road to the A201 in the direction of Brussels Airport (dates subject to change). A diversion will be in place via [Henneaulaan](#).
- **May 8 (9:00 p.m.) – May 10:** Reduced lane availability on both the inner and outer Ring Road due to the removal of scaffolding under the bridges. Please allow for extra travel time.
- **May 23:** The connection between Evere and the outer Ring Road will be closed. A diversion via [Henneaulaan](#) will apply.

4. Resurfacing of the BRUcargo roundabouts

On June 6, the roundabout near Delhaize will be resurfaced. The roundabout near ESSO is scheduled for June 13. During these works, the roundabouts will be closed from 4 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day. Detours will be put in place and announced at a later date.

5. North-South viaduct to become one-way

After the roadworks at the Strabet roundabout, the North-South viaduct will become a **one-way road from south to north for both cyclists and motorised traffic**, with a weight limit of 16 tonnes. The TUI roundabout will be converted into an **intersection** to improve safety and traffic flow in the direction of the airport.

The works 1 and 3 are part of the "Work on the Ring Road" project.
