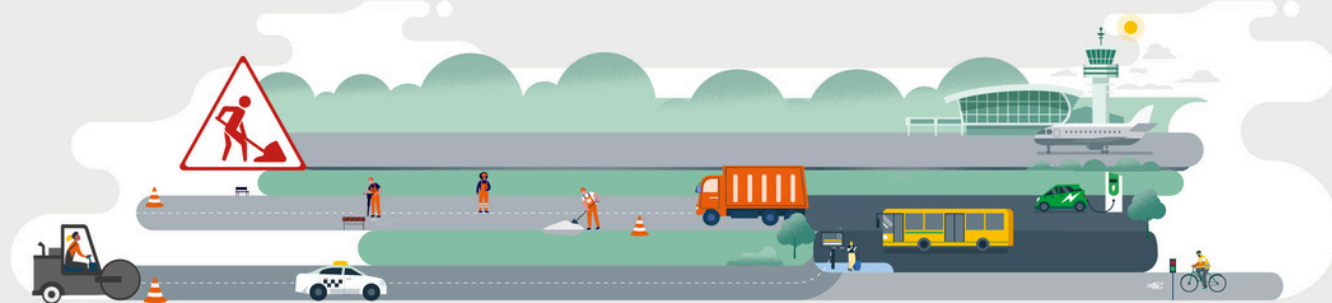




Mobility Flash - September-October 2026

Dear colleague,

With this Mobility Flash, we would like to inform you about upcoming works on the access roads to and from Brussels Airport. Below please find an overview of the major changes for **September-October***.

1. N227 tunnel pavement renovation in Steenokkerzeel extended by two weeks

Brussels Airport and the Agency for Roads and Traffic are currently renovating the pavement of the tunnel under runway 07R/25L on Tervuursesteenweg in Steenokkerzeel. During the works, it became apparent that additional concrete repairs were necessary. As a result, the tunnel will remain fully closed until mid-September. Until then, traffic will continue to be diverted via the E40.

2. Additional travel time from Antwerp

From **10 August to 26 September**, the Roads and Traffic Agency will be carrying out maintenance work on the E19 link road from Antwerp to the Brussels inner ring road (R0) towards Brussels Airport. One lane will remain open at all times, but significant traffic disruption is expected. Allow for extra travel time or consider using public transport, if you're commuting from Antwerp to the airport.

3. Works for the Airport Tram along Ringlaan

Preparatory works for the future Airport Tram along Ringlaan, between B.house and Building 8, has been completed. The actual utility works for the airport tram will begin on **14 September**. These works will continue until **mid-October** and will once again result in alternating traffic on Ringlaan, from B.house to Building 8.

4. Take part in the Mobility Week

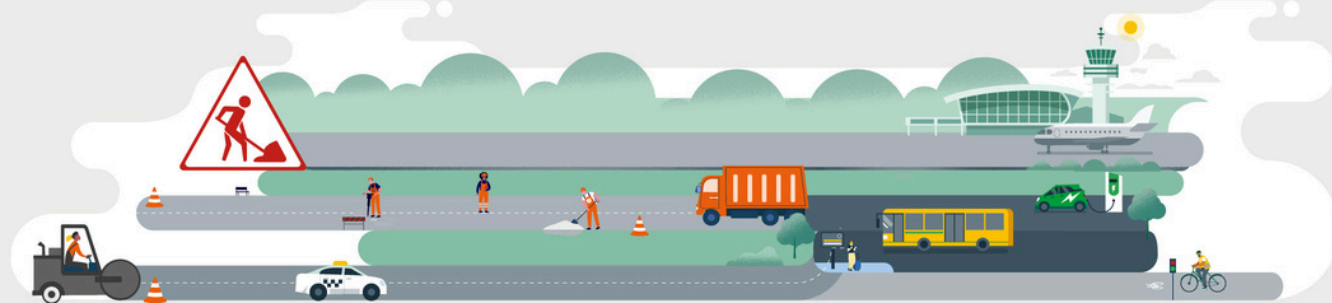

5. Car-Free Sunday on 20 September

6. New cycle path under construction at BRUcargo

A new cycle path is under construction on **Watertorenlaan at BRUcargo**. The cycle path will be ready for use **by mid-October**.

The new cycle path also provides easy access on foot to the BRUcargo West bus stop. This will make the site safer and even more readily accessible for cyclists.

7. First high-speed train from Cologne to Brussels Airport

On **7 September**, the **first Deutsche Bahn high-speed train from Cologne will arrive at Brussels Airport station**.

This means that, after more than ten years, the airport is once again directly connected to the international high-speed network. This new connection strengthens our international connectivity and our role as an intermodal hub.
